 - New bells installed, quiet and short
- ★ Teacher's Report Vi Roxas, Lynda Eilers, Camille Johnson
 - Vi Roxas thanks for field trip, planned field trip with two other TK classes to Monterey Bay Aquarium, setting up Winter Wonderland dramatic play area (solicit parent participation and use stipend)
 - Camille Johnson kinder field trip going to Children's Discovery Museum in April and bringing YSI come in snakes, etc. at end of April
 - Used teacher stipend: for letter exchange in postage, expand calm corners
 - Walkathon offer for communication!
- ★ Board Member Report Carol Presunka and Janet Gillis
 - January is open enrollment for the school, priority to residents until the end of March, all 4
 year olds are now included, any school who is full will have a lottery
 - o New strategic plan and looking for community input

- Will be tight budget year based on COLA adjustment

 - Videographer quote, looking for additional \$1000 for t-shirts (getting all ticket sales revenue)
 - Added line items for ticket purchases and out for t-shirts → Dave move to approve, Brittni second 19 approvals, no objections
- o PNO- Kelly J currently on the calendar for February 10, looking to postpone it to March
 - Next movie night is February 9
 - Looking at March 23 (Hapas in San Jose live auction, Number One Broadway in Los Gatos) → looking at keeping this around \$60-\$80 per person, covers meals and at least a beverage
